### Dukeries Farmers Branch - 5.0%

Cask ale

Zesty pale ale with lager malts. This pale strong ale is zesty with fresh clean citrus notes.

### Dukeries Heritage Pale - 4.4%

Cask ale

Pale yellow citrus ale with herbal and earthy characteristics. Mid bitter finish.

### Magpie Eight is a wish - 4.2%

Cask ale

Exciting blend of new British hops with a distinct spiced fruit Belgian twist

### Marston Thwaites Wainwright - 4.1%

Cask ale

Named after Alfred Wainwright, the renowned Lakeland author who was born in Blackburn in 1907. A refreshing straw-coloured beer with soft fruit flavours and a hint of sweetness from the fine malt.

### Milestone Boston Bitter - 5.0%

Cask ale

Bold, fruity and hoppy dark red American style bitter. Has the taste of a traditional strong dark ale.

### Milton Justinian - 3.9%

Cask ale

Crisp pale bronze coloured bitter. Attractive bitter orange flavours persist into a satisfying lasting finish.

### Plain India Plain Ale - 5.2%

Cask ale

Wonderful aroma of bitter oranges and spicy hops combine with biscuit malt. A persistent finish, bitter, tangy, fruity, and with lingering hoppiness. IPA as it should be.

### Tring Side Pocket for a Toad - 3.6%

Cask ale

Unmistakable citrus and floral notes from only the best American Cascade hops balanced with a crisp dry finish make this straw coloured ale a fantastic session beer.

Not a fruit beer, a beer with fruit. The malt base creates a sweetness to compliment the mango infusion. A lot of late hopping with Chinook and Cascade gives a juxtaposing bitterness that balances this beer to perfection. Dry hopped with Citra.

Cask ale

Brewed with Waimea and Kohatu hops from New Zealand, Eighty Eight is clean and well-balanced with a moderate level of bitterness. Subtle biscuit maltiness allows aromas and flavour of tangerine, pine needle and citrus flavours to come to the fore.

### Roosters Pilsnear - 4.8%

Cask ale

This Pale Ale isn't quite a Pilsner, but it's been brewed with Noble hops from Germany and the Czech Republic, along with Pilsner and Munich malts, before being fermented at a low temperature.

### Thornbridge Crackendale - 5.2%

Cask ale

Crackendale explodes with a fantastic tropical fruit aroma, giving way to guava and ripe citrus which burst through on the palate with a beautiful bitter and sweet balance.

### Thornbridge Jaipur - 5.9%

Cask ale

A citrus dominated India Pale Ale, its immediate impression is soft and smooth yet builds to a crescendo of massive hoppiness accentuated by honey. An enduring, bitter finish.
